

Assistance League® of Salt Lake City Mentor Program Policy

Assistance League of Salt Lake City may manage and conduct a Mentor Program with the following goal: to welcome, educate, integrate, support and retain new Assistance League members. The Mentor Program is intended to provide networking and social connections.

I. Management

- A.** A Mentor Program Coordinator shall be appointed by the Member Services Committee Chairman, and approved by the Board.
- B.** The Mentor Program Coordinator shall serve on the New Member Orientation committee for the purpose of overseeing the Mentor Program.
- C.** This Mentor Program shall be in compliance with National Assistance League® Policies for Chapters and chapter policy standards.
- D.** The Mentor Program Coordinator shall coordinate the pairing of prospective mentors and mentees with the New Member Orientation Chair.

II. Standards

- A.** The Mentor Program Coordinator shall follow “Mentor Program Guidelines”, the “Mentor/New Member Checklist,” and other documents included in the Mentor Program Coordinator’s Mentor Program procedure handbook.
- B.** Mentees may request or decline to be paired with a mentor.
- C.** Mentors may be any voting or auxiliary member of Assistance League.
- D.** The mentor and mentee relationship is flexible and shall continue as long as deemed useful by the parties involved.
